Legendary Mosel wine maker here with this delicate and elegant Riesling. Heady with lime, herbs and apple notes combined with delicious freshness.

Fantastic single vineyard white from a pioneering organic English wine producer. We like to think this has Sancerre qualities - steely yet herbacious and delicate citrus fruit.

Cotes du Rhone Domaine de Ronciere, France 2015	£7.00	£14.00	£27.00
Vibrant and juicy. Supple dark plum and blackberry fruit with a gentle mouthfilling tannin.			
Saumur Champigny Chateau du Hureau, France 2013			£28.00
The 'Tuffe' or 'Tuffeau' is the Loire Limestone which gives the fresh red plum its mineral quality, adding a graphite stoniness to the pure fruit.			
Gaillac Verdemnia, Domaine de Brin, France 2014	£7.50	£15.00	£29.00
Mostly Duras, with 20% Merlot, the Brin is typical of Gaillac with deep plummy fruit, dusty tannin and granite.			
Morgon Domaine du Penlois Beaujolais, France 2014	£8.00	£16.00	£30.00
From one of Beaujolais' 10 famous Village Crus, this is light and fresh with juicy red cherry and strawberry. For those who swear by Decanter points, this wine gained 97 of them!			
Pinot Noir Peter Yealands, Marlborough, New Zealand 2015	£10.00	£20.00	£39.00
Peter Yealands is well known for sustainable practices and in particular the specific breed of sheep he uses to help him weed the vineyards. This is juicy, supple, cherry-led and beautiful.			
Barbera Dal Zotto, King Valley, Victoria Australia 2014			£42.00
One of a number of winemakers in South Australia specialising in Italian grape varieties. This natural, unfiltered wine is a lively smooth, plummy Barbera with some meatiness.			
Finca Allende Reserva Rioja, Spain 2009			£45.00
When Tempranillo meets wood. A developed Rioja with savoury flavours of wood spice, mellow red fruit and gentle yet serious tannins.			
Mendel Cabernet Sauvignon Mendoza, Argentina 2015			£48.00
As with many Argentinian Cabs, you don't get the leafy style of European examples. Instead, its juicy, bursting with blackcurrants and plums and hints of smoky leather!			
Reverdito Barolo Piemonte, Italy 2012			£48.00
Aged in large Buttes to avoid overpowering new oak this is classically styled Barolo from one of the area's stars. Dried fruits, violets, leather - that complex balance between power and fragrance.			
L'Esprit de Chevalier Pessac Leognan, France 2013			£50.00
The second wine from the great Domaine de Chevalier, this Bordeaux blend achieves a great balance between sweet cassis savoury oak and that mineral, earthy Pessac quality.
